Each year more than 200 football clubs take part in UEFA's European club competitions. To do so they are forced to abide with UEFA's Licensing and Financial Fair Play Regulations. In 2014, for the first time, high profile European clubs (PSG and Manchester City) faced sanctions after being found in breach of the FFP regulations. This has clearly demonstrated that FFP regulations are here to stay and will be rigorously enforced by UEFA. Anyone trying to get a foothold in the football industry will need a good grasp of these regulations. This year's ASSER International Sport Law Summer Programme will make sure that you do!
