

Sixth Annual Summer Programme on Disarmament and Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction

Update: Confirmed speaker Dr Sibylle Bauer, Director of the Dual-use and Arms Trade Control Programme at the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute, will speak on Export Control Regimes

Sibylle Bauer will give an overview of the international and European political, legal and institutional framework for export controls regarding dual-use items and arms. A particular focus will be placed on the export control regimes seeking to establish standards for controlling the trade in dual-use items with applications in chemical, biological and nuclear weapons and their delivery systems. Regimes seeking to control the trade in conventional weapons and related goods and technologies will also be discussed. Finally, ongoing challenges regarding the implementation and enforcement of export, brokering, transit and trans-shipment controls will be explored.

A short biography:

Dr Sibylle Bauer is Director of the Dual-use and Arms Trade Control Programme at the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute. She holds a PhD in Political Science jointly from the Free University of Brussels (ULB) and the Free University of Berlin. Dr Bauer has published widely on dual-use and armaments-related issues.

Since 2005 she has spent much of her time on capacity-building to enhance transit, transhipment, brokering and export controls for dual-use items, with a focus on Europe and South East Asia. This has included responsibility for national and regional activities on legal, industry outreach and enforcement issues.
