- The publication of the ***Yearbook of International Humanitarian Law***, Volume 16, 2013 (General Editor: Terry Gill), dealing with the topics of Detention in Non-International Armed Conflict and Essays on the Boundaries of the Battlefield and the ***Netherlands Yearbook of International Law***, Volume 44, 2013, with Mielle Bulterman and Willem van Genugten, as the Editors of the volume on 'Crisis and International Law: Decoy or Catalyst?'
- Three of its book titles were **reprinted** in 2014.
- **Marianne Hirsch Ballin** received the prestigious **SIRACUSA PRIZE 2014** from the International Association of Penal Law and the International Institute of Higher Studies in Criminal Sciences for her monograph *Anticipative Criminal Investigation. Theory and Counterterrorism Practice in the Netherlands and the United States.*
- Asser Press has had an active and successful year in **acquiring, publishing and promoting its publications at many local meetings and at major international conferences**, such as the American Society of International Law (Washington, DC), the

European Society of International Law (Vienna), FIDE (Copenhagen), and the International Association of Constitutional Law (Oslo).

- Asser Press organised several **book launches** at the T.M.C. Asser Instituut, such as for *Applying International Humanitarian Law in Judicial and Quasi-Judicial Bodies: International and Domestic Aspects*, *The European Public Prosecutor's Office: An Extended Arm or a Two-Headed Dragon?*, and the second edition of Weatherill's *European Sports Law – Collected Papers*.
