A default judgment was entered today against defendant Emmanuel Constant, a.k.a "Toto Constant," in the litigation entitled <u>Doe v. Constant</u>, 04 Civ. 10108 (S.D.N.Y.). The action concerns allegations that members of a former Haitian paramilitary organization led by defendant Constant tortured and exacted other forms of violence upon three pseudonymous plaintiffs during a period of unrest in Haiti in the early 1990s. The plaintiffs' claims of torture, attempted extrajudicial killing, and crimes against humanity were brought pursuant to the Alien Tort Statute, 28 U.S.C. § 1350, and the Torture Victims Protection Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1350 (note). A hearing on damages will be held in Courtroom 23A, U.S. Courthouse, 500 Pearl St., New York, NY 10007, beginning on August 29, 2006 at 9:30 a.m. I am attaching a copy of the Complaint.

This letter is to inform you of the existence of this litigation and pending hearing. Should the government wish to be heard in any way in this litigation, see <u>Banco Nacional de Cuba v. Sabbatino</u>, 376 U.S. 398, 416, 11 L. Ed. 2d 804, 84 S. Ct. 923 (1964), please respond to this letter before the damages hearing commences on August 29.
