Who may apply:

This training is intended for senior civil servants, Judges, Public Prosecutors and Officers employed by the national Ministries of Justice/(semi) governmental organisations and charged with the development of the organisation of the Judicial procedure in their respective countries.

Eligible countries:

Application is open to participants from: Albania Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, and Turkey

Fees:

The Netherlands Government will provide full fellowships to selected participants. Each fellowship will cover the cost of international travel (economy), board and lodging in The Hague, visa and insurance, tuition fees, lecture materials, field trips and excursions.

Training Programme structure: A balance between theory, practical skills and field trips.

Language of Instruction: English.

Training programme objective:

Through this MATRA PATROL training programme, the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs aims to stimulate, support and contribute to the efficient implementation of the EU *Acquis* in the area of 'rule of law' and to strengthen relations between the Netherlands and the target countries and amongst the target countries by sharing the necessary knowledge and skills with policy advisors, members of the judiciary and other civil servants working in the justice sector such that they may lead and inspire the modernisation of the judicial systems of their home countries .
