Who may apply:

This training is intended for Senior civil servants of all (semi) governmental organisations and charged with the involved in public procurement in their respective countries .

Eligible countries:

Application is open for civil servants from: Albania Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, and Turkey

Fees:

The Netherlands Government will provide full fellowships to selected participants. Each fellowship will cover the cost of international travel (economy), board and lodging in The Hague, visa and insurance, tuition fees, lecture materials, field trips and excursions.

Training Programme structure: A balance between theory, practical skills and field trips.
