Registration Procedure

1. You may register via the website by submitting the completed online registration form at: www.asser.academy/register/ILPI2019.aspx
2. Each participant should use a separate form.
3. Upon completion of the online registration form, you will be directed to an online payment environment.
4. Your place in the workshop is confirmed only when the online registration form has been submitted and the payment has been received.
5. The registration form constitutes a legally binding agreement. By submitting the completed registration form, the registrant declares to be in accordance with the requirements and provisions described therein.
6. The T.M.C. Asser Instituut cannot be held responsible for the non-arrival of registration information. If you have not received an automatic e-mail concerning your registration within 24 hours of submitting, please contact conferencemanager@asser.nl.
