On or about March 12, 2006, outside the United States, to wit, in Mahmudiyah, Iraq, while a member of the United States Army, subject to Chapter 47 of Title 10 (the Uniform Code of Military Justice), the defendant, Steven D. Green, did, with malice aforethought, unlawfully kill another person, an Iraqi man, by shooting, an offense punishable by more than one year if committed in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7, 1111, and 3261(a)(2).

On or about March 12, 2006, outside the United States, to wit, in Mahmudiyah, Iraq, while a member of the United States Army, subject to Chapter 47 of Title 10 (the Uniform Code of Military Justice), the defendant, Steven D. Green, did, with malice aforethought, unlawfully kill another person, an Iraqi woman, by shooting, an offense punishable by more than one year if committed in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7, 1111, and 3261(a)(2).

On or about March 12, 2006, outside the United States, to wit, in Mahmudiyah, Iraq, while a member of the United States Army, subject to Chapter 47 of Title 10 (the Uniform Code of Military Justice), the defendant, Steven D. Green, did, with malice aforethought, unlawfully kill another person, an Iraqi child, by shooting, an offense punishable by more than one year if committed in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7, 1111, and 3261(a)(2).

On or about March 12, 2006, outside the United States, to wit, in Mahmudiyah, Iraq, while a member of the United States Army, subject to Chapter 47 of Title 10 (the Uniform Code of Military Justice), the defendant, Steven D. Green, did, with malice aforethought, unlawfully kill another person, by shooting, in the perpetration of aggravated sexual abuse against that person, an Iraqi woman, an offense punishable by more than one year if committed in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7, 1111, and 3261(a)(2).

On or about March 12, 2006, outside the United States, to wit, in Mahmudiyah, Iraq, while a member of the United States Army, subject to Chapter 47 of Title 10 (the Uniform Code of Military Justice), the defendant, Steven D. Green, did knowingly cause another person to engage in a sexual act by using force against that other person, an offense punishable by more than one year if committed in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7, 2241, and 3261(a)(2).
